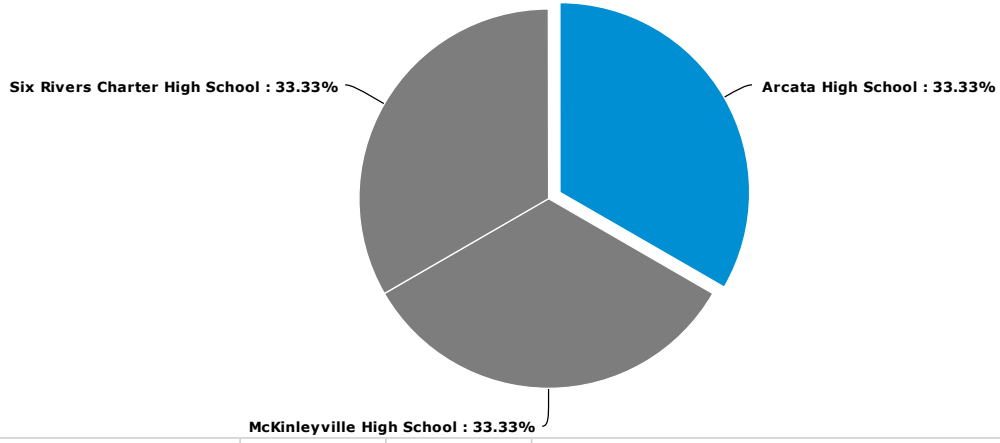

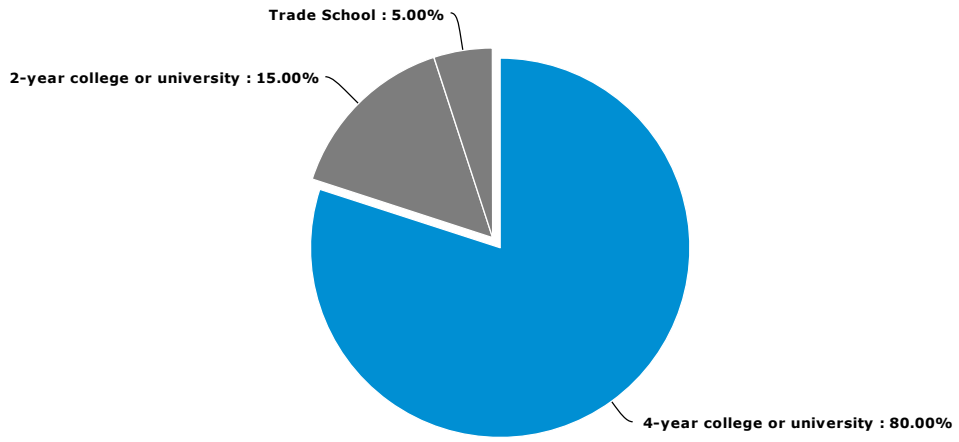

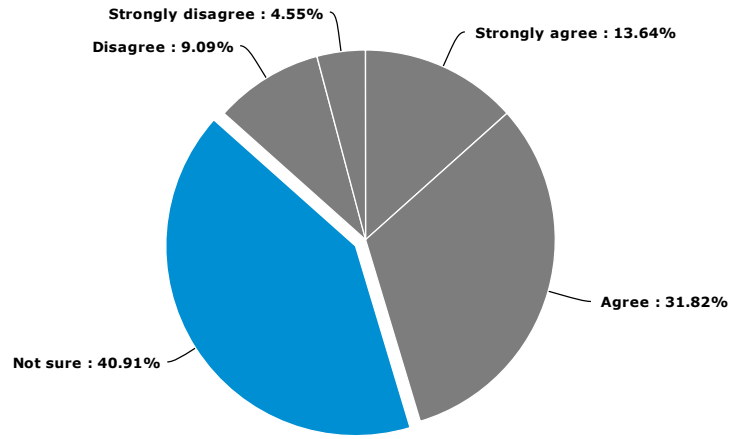

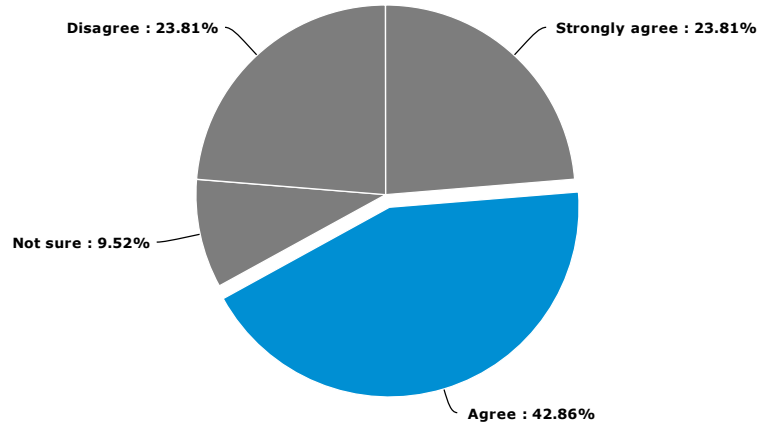

Does the school focus on improving student attendance?

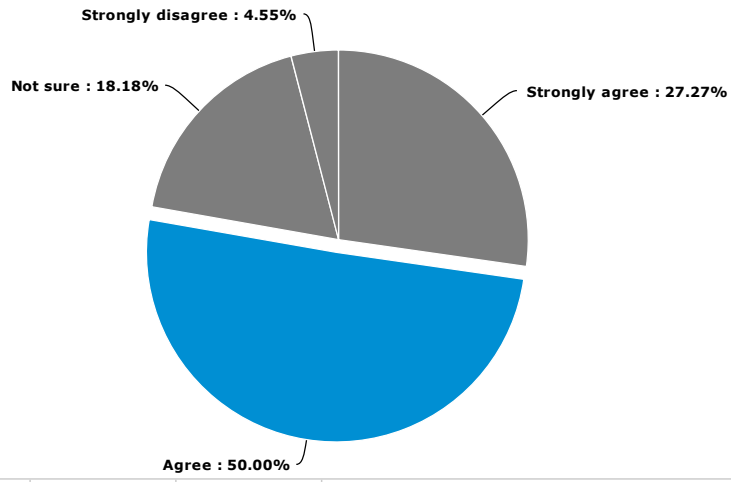

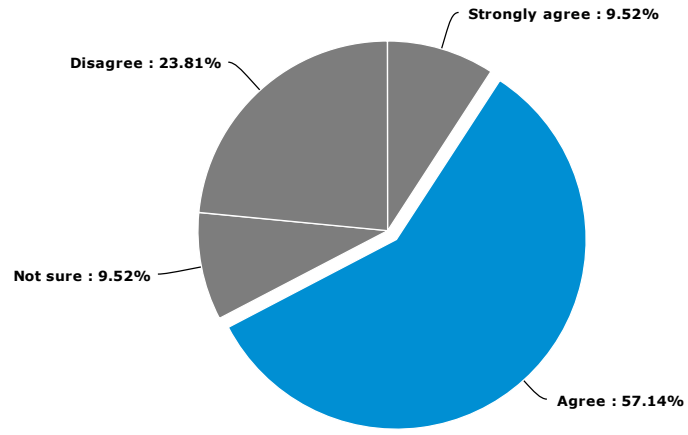

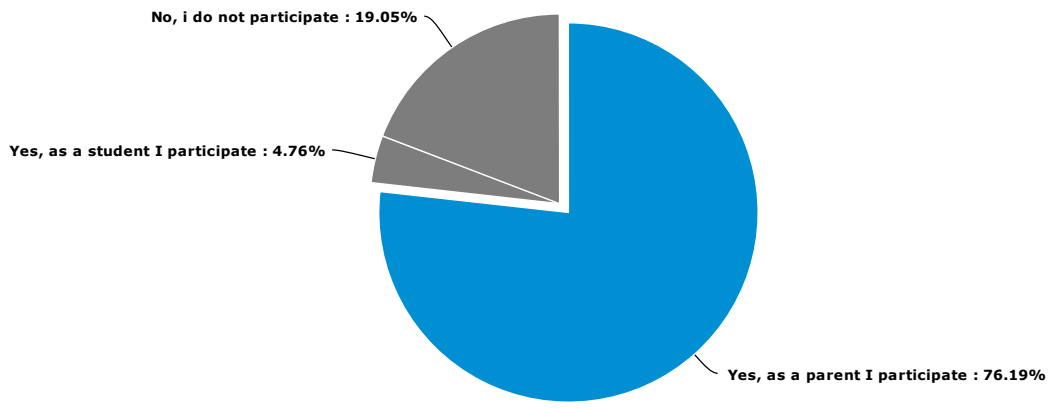

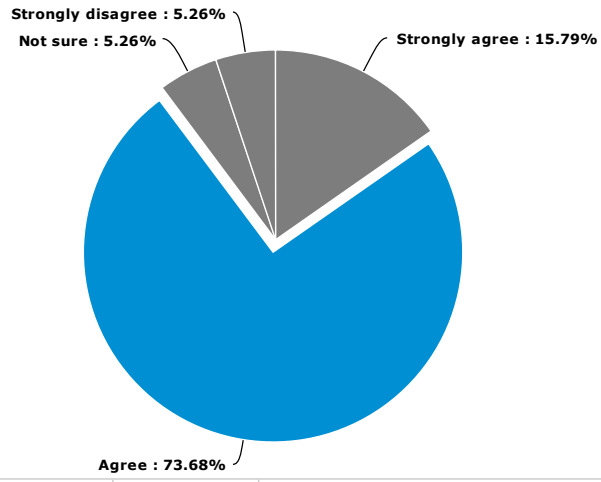

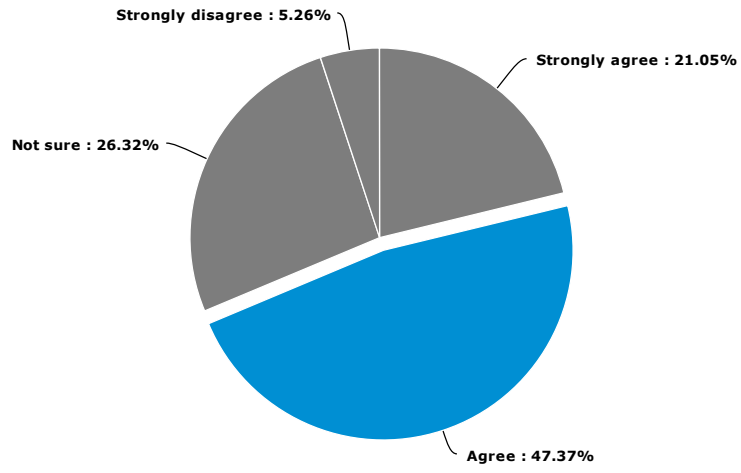

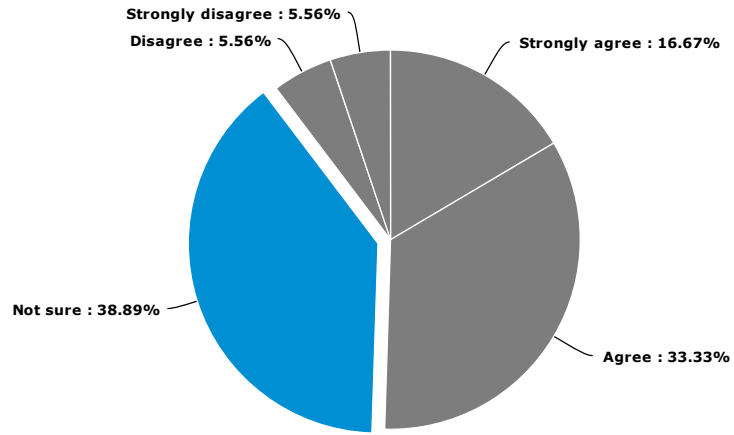

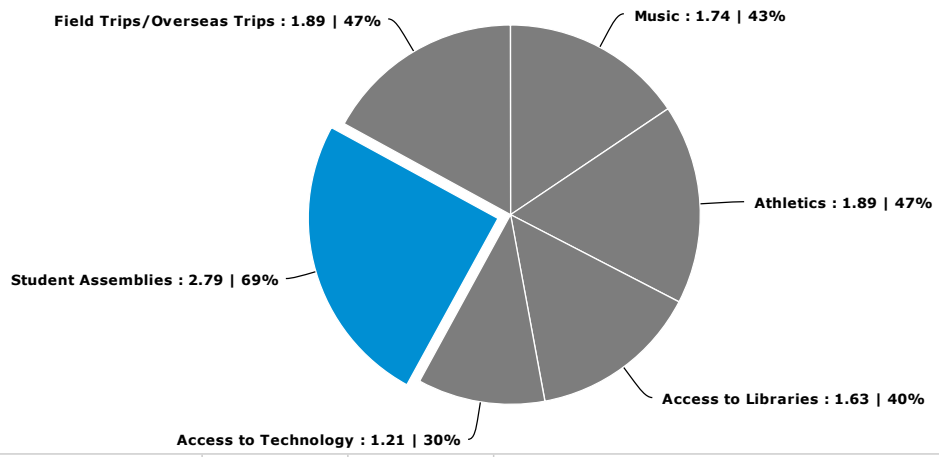

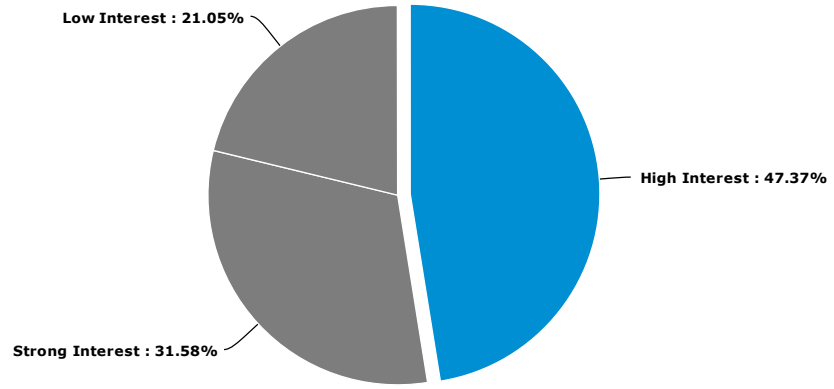

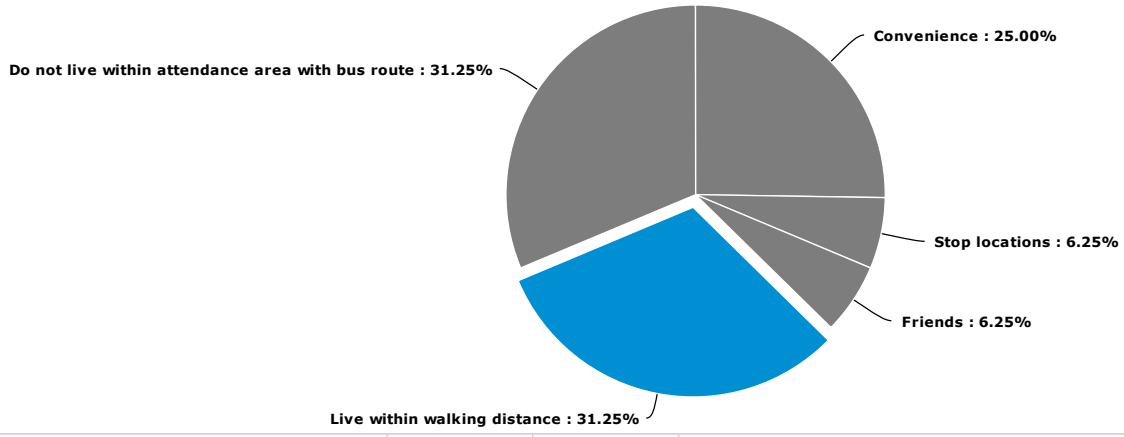

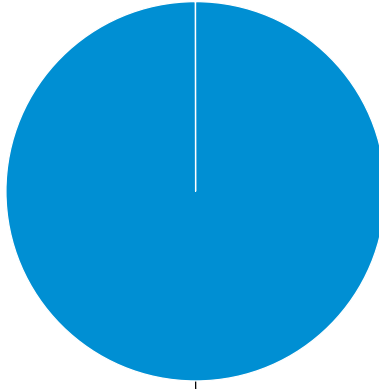

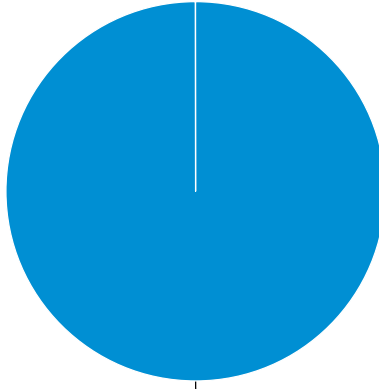

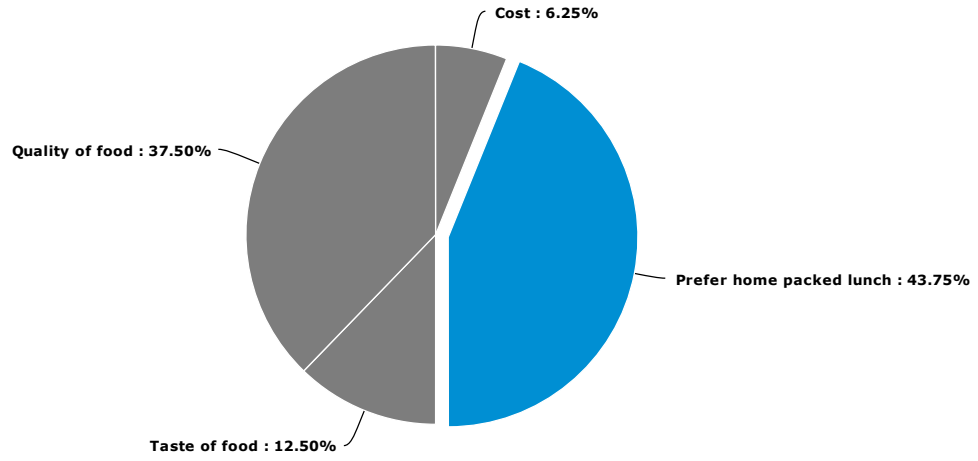
